- 1. Actions completed since the 2015 Mid-Year Meeting: (Please bullet actions completed.)
  - Annual Drive completed; record setting donations total \$ 32,173
  - That amount represents nearly \$9000 above the average year's donations
  - And approx. 90% above the previous year's donations
  - Membership donations and other gifts in addition to Annual Drive totaled \$43,308.05
  - All donations, including the Mertz gift of \$115k totaled \$ 190,481.05
  - There were more than 300 donors.
  - Factoids: 1 \$10k; 1 \$8k; 1 \$2500; 1 \$2k and 8 \$1k donors
  - There were just under 200 unrestricted donations
  - There were just over 100 Restricted donations.
  - We have a complete list of individual, named donors and amounts.
  - There was one donor who shall remain nameless who finally provided a significant gift (\$2500) after five years of "work" in terms of visits, meetings, reporting on progress and cajoling. We finally found something that struck a nerve.
- 2. Actions begun but incomplete since the 2015 Mid-Year Meeting: (Please bullet actions begun.)
  - In preparation for next year's Annual Drive, I am seeking input from the Fund Raising advisors (Nancy Burton, Dr. Karl Saunders, Dr. Marie Jureit and others) on best method going forward for doing three things acknowledging donors publicly, while recognizing there are those who wish to remain anonymous
  - Prepare the final draft of a fund raising brochure, and determine best timing for distribution, i.e. part of Annual Drive? Distinct from Annual Drive?
  - Discuss with these individuals and the board the best timing to announce a major capital campaign.
